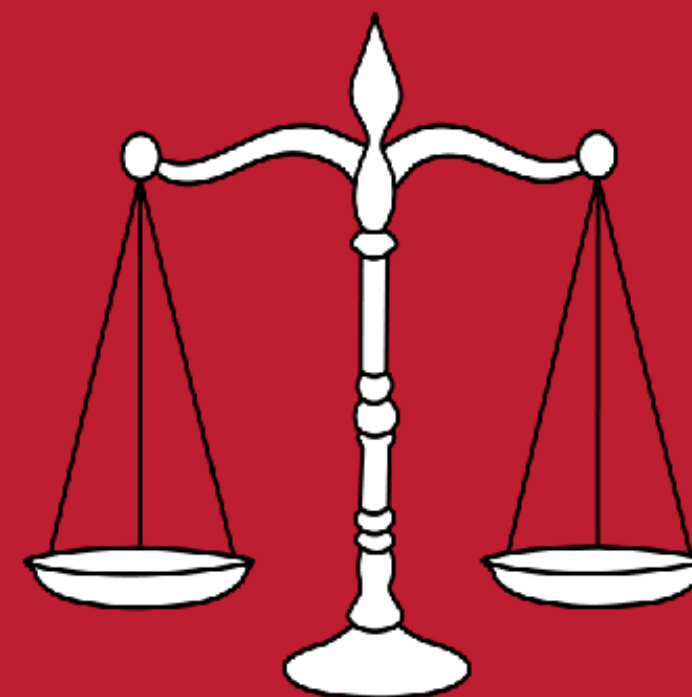

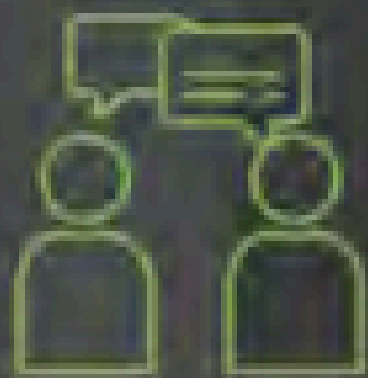

### IRRIGATION TECHNICIAN



The ALCA Certified Irrigation Technician Training (ACIT) Program consists of a 3-day training including hands-on activities focused on the optimization of water usage and the efficiency of existing irrigation systems.

### CERTIFICATION

Must attend all 3 classes and pass ACIT Exam to receive ACIT Certification

### SITE ASSESSMENT

- Evaluate existing irrigation systems using checklist
- Site conditions - general plant health, plant problems, infrastructure problems, water pooling, plant type, microclimate, orientation
- Review plans, draw irrigation diagram
- Irrigation components - inventory and condition
- Zoning stations and controller programming
- Assess system baseline performance
- Determine Precipitation Rates (PR)

### MAXIMIZING EFFICIENCY

- Determine how much water and pressure needed
- Manage pressure loss
- Determine plant water needs & calculate ET rates
- Calculate/maximize Distribution Uniformity (DU)
- Calculate run times for maximum efficiency
- Manage irrigation schedule according to ET
- Use water management technology and techniques

### TROUBLESHOOTING & REPAIR

- Identify common irrigation malfunctions and identify solutions
- Practice the skills necessary to troubleshoot
- Repairing irrigation lines, sprinkler systems, controllers, and water management technology

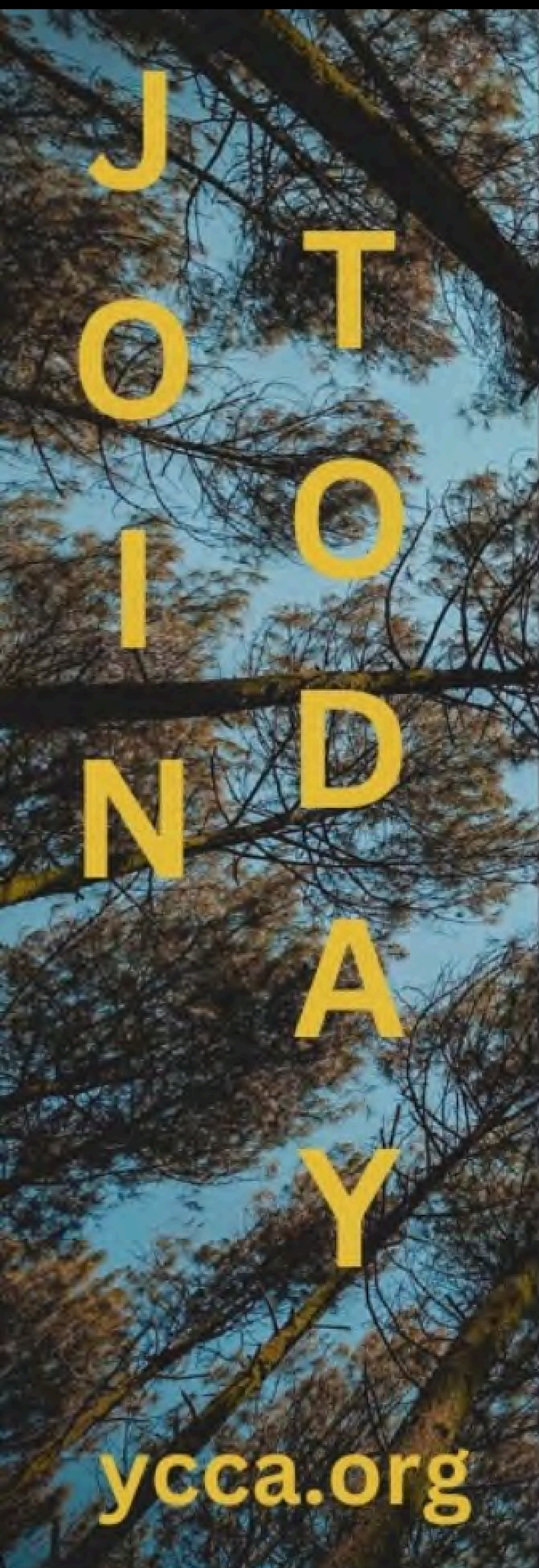

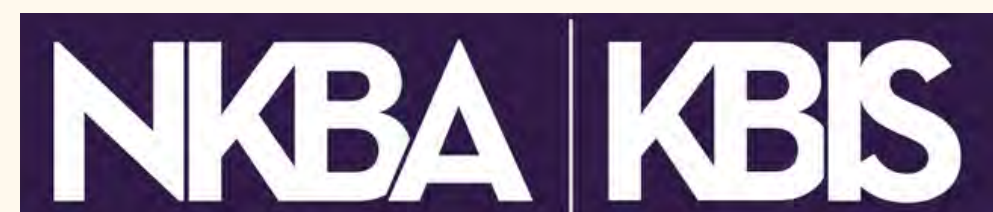
