### AGENCY DISCLOSURE

## FELONY DISCLOSURE FORM

### Instructions

Review the following information and complete and sign the Felony Disclosure Form. If the person being added to the license has been convicted of a felony, or has a pending felony charge, that person **must** complete and sign this form.

### Good Character Standard

Arizona law requires that every person named on a license have good character and reputation. Certain issues regarding good character and reputation can cause a license to be delayed or denied. A felony conviction can indicate a lack of good character and reputation. A.R.S. § 32-1122(C) & A.R.S. § 32-1154(A)(7).

### Documentation to Enable Review of Felony Convictions

Every person with a felony conviction **must** submit the following documents here:

- A copy of the charging document (*typically called the indictment or complaint*)
- A copy of the courts findings or plea agreement
- A copy of the presentence report
- Documentation of the sentence
- Documentation showing completion of the sentence
- Documentation showing satisfaction of restitution (*if applicable*)
- A copy of the order restoring civil rights (*if applicable*)

Every person with a felony conviction **may** submit additional documents showing a rehabilitation of character and reputation here:

- A letter explaining:
  - 1) The circumstances of the felony, and
  - 2) Steps taken to avoid those circumstances in the future
- Letters of reference from:
  - 1) Licensed contractors
  - 2) Employers or business associates
  - 3) Any victims affected by the felony
  - 4) Religious or charitable institutions
  - 5) Recovery programs
  - 6) Family, friends, and neighbors
- Documents showing completion of an addiction-recovery or other relevant program; and
- Documents showing personal, professional or educational achievements after the felony conviction.

- Evidence of payment to the person who filed the complaint
- Evidence that corrective work was completed satisfactorily
- Evidence that all reasonable efforts to resolve the underlying cause of the suspension or revocation were undertaken.

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## UNLICENSED ACTIVITY DISCLOSURE FORM

### Instructions

Review the following information and complete and sign the Unlicensed Activity Disclosure Form. If any person named on a license application was issued a civil citation or convicted for contracting without a license, that person **must** complete and sign this form.

The Registrar requires that each person cited or convicted for contracting without a license complete a separate form.

Each person must complete and sign this form for every instance where they were charged or convicted for contracting without a license.

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### Good Character Standard

Arizona law requires that every person named on a license have good character and reputation. Certain issues regarding good character and reputation can cause a license to be delayed or denied. Being named on a contractor's license that was suspended or revoked can indicate a lack of good character. A.R.S. § 32-1122(C).

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### Evidence of Remedial Measures

To avoid delay or denial, every person previously charged or convicted for contracting without a license should submit documents showing that remedial measures have been taken. A.R.S. § 32-1166.07.

Examples of those documents include the below and can be uploaded here:

- Evidence of payment to remedy all loss or damage to the public; or
- Evidence of any remedial measures taken.
