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AZ ROC Revokes CCS K Lee Enterprise's License

PHOENIX, Ariz., (June 9, 2015) – On Tues., June 2, 2015, Arizona Registrar of Contractors (AZ ROC) revoked CCS K Lee Enterprises, Inc.'s license following a default order for failure to respond to a citation.

AZ ROC filed a Default Decision and Order following CCS K Lee Enterprises' failure to file a timely written answer to a citation issued against the contractor.

The citation resulting in revocation alleged three counts to include one count of failure to meet minimum construction standards, one count of failure to meet minimum elements of a contract, and one count of failure to take appropriate corrective action as required by the Registrar's Directive.

Six additional citations have impending Default Decisions and Orders of Revocation. The remaining citations allege 13 additional counts; including four counts of abandoning a contract without legal excuse, four counts of failure to meet minimum elements of a contract, and one count each of modifying a contract price, failure to meet minimum construction standards, failure to take appropriate corrective action as required by the Registrar's Directive, doing of a fraudulent act by failing to refund a down payment resulting in another person being substantially injured and contracting with a suspended license.

Apart from the seven cases with citations described, an additional ten complaints are being investigated by AZ ROC.

The revoked license, license number 211423, was for a B-3, Residential General Remodeling and Repair Contractor.

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
