William Mundell Appointed to NASCLA Board of Directors

The National Association of State Contractors Licensing Agencies (NASCLA) recently appointed William Mundell to its Board of Directors. Mr. Mundell is the Director of the Arizona Registrar of Contractors.

NASCLA was formed in 1962 to improve regulation of the construction industry in order to protect the health, welfare and safety of the general public. The association's membership is comprised of state and local contractor licensing agencies, construction firms, construction trade associations and others associated with the construction industry. NASCLA's membership includes more than 28 states expanding from Hawaii to Guam.

As a Board member, Director Mundell will help establish the governing policies and procedures for the management and operation of the Association.
